

## WeBS COUNTS IN THE LONDON AREA, 2011-2012

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As with previous years, we will look at the London Area and how important it is for wildfowl on an international and national scale. We can now look at the prior year's data and identify changes in populations or preferred locations. There are still gaps in our knowledge, with some sites not covered fully during the period, but more sites have been covered this year. We hope that in the future there will be nearly full coverage of all sites, which will enable a more extensive review of the area to be made.

The WeBS sites are divided into nine regions, which are listed on pages 2-3: page 2 lists the sites within each region; page 3 lists the sites alphabetically by name.

The number of counts that reached International and National Important Levels (IIL and NIL respectively) increased, with new species being added: Smew, Avocet, Dunlin, Black-tailed Godwit and Common Sandpiper. The threshold for Common Sandpiper is very low; this resulted in it being included in most regions of the London Area, which is misleading.

Currently, no NIL is set for Common Tern; however, the count of 124 in the Lea Valley in May 2012 is significant at a national level. The NIL for Moorhen is set at 3,200, but this species is difficult to count and therefore any counts greater than 200 are noteworthy. This moves the Outer Thames into the table with 213 birds in December 2011, Middlesex with 237 in September 2011, the Lea Valley with 296 in March 2012, and finally Inner Thames with 385 in December 2011. Water Rail, with no NIL set, is very difficult to observe and so any sites with counts greater than ten birds are likely to be significant. There are several relevant counts, with the Inner Thames 12 birds in January 2012, the Lea Valley ten birds in March 2012 and the Outer Thames 12 in March 2012. These will represent a fraction of the total birds wintering in the London Area. So while the table page 4 shows the sites reaching IIL and NIL, it does not provide the full picture.

The table on pages 5-6 shows the Wetland Bird Survey (WeBS\*) for the whole of the London Area from July 2011 to June 2012. Pages 6 to 14 show the following nine regions:

All counts are completed on a monthly basis and are attempted to be completed on the same dates throughout the country to allow totals to be compiled, which are then comparable.

Several sites were not counted throughout the period. One was the River Thames - Barking Bay: this affects the numbers of Shelduck in the area, which show a 62% drop in the total number of birds counted. Another was Grovelands Park, a stronghold for Mandarin Duck: this species shows an increase of 32%, but this was due to more birds being present on Hampstead Heath. So the picture is not necessarily clear.

There are possible changes to the preferred site for some species. Wigeon numbers have not changed significantly but they increased at Rainham Marshes (+26%) and Staines Reservoirs (+50%). These sites may have become more favourable (and others less so) with habitat changes. It would be expected that the continual improvements of some sites will have made them more important for some species - Rainham Marshes RSPB is likely to feature more prominently due to this fact.

All data included here are only present in the BTO-managed WeBS database, which is used to identify important areas in the UK.

\* During each WeBS count, observers are asked to count swans, geese, ducks, divers, grebes, herons, cormorants, crakes, waders, skuas, gulls, terns and kingfishers and, within all these families, escapees and hybrids.
